Bass Island Line Update – edition 8

Repairs to the “Investigator II” in Devonport are now complete and general cargo sailings to King Island will resume this afternoon.

BIL continues to work closely with its livestock customer to organise the movement of their cattle that regrettably were delayed while ship repairs were completed. BIL would like to thank our customer for their cooperation on this issue.

The next two sailings on BIL are as follows

1. Thursday 1 June: General cargo (including fertiliser) – Depart Devonport 6pm.
2. Saturday 3 June: General cargo (including fertiliser) – Depart Devonport 1pm.

As of today (1 June), BIL has delivered 420 containers to King Island, including 147 fertiliser containers. Current bookings on the next two sailings are as follows:

1. Thursday 1 June: 25 containers, including 19 fertiliser.
2. Saturday 3 June: 24 containers, including 18 fertiliser.
