## Smooth sailing

Services for the upcoming weekend are running on schedule.

The *Investigator II* is set to depart on Sunday 1 October at 1pm and will arrive in Grassy at 7am on Monday 2 October.

## Freight to date

Since commencing operation on 7 April 2017 BIL has moved 29,011 tonnes of freight into and off King Island including fertiliser, livestock, fuel, groceries, stockfeed, household goods, construction materials, agricultural equipment, motor vehicles and TasWater’s King Island pipeline project cargo.
