Delivering

It's business as usual this week for Bass Island Line (BIL).

We completed four sailings in the last week with one general cargo and three livestock. This included approximately 400 tonnes of general cargo and 800 head of cattle.

With your support, we have now completed a total of 114 voyages.

This includes 62 general cargo voyages between Devonport and Grassy and 52 livestock sailings between Grassy and Stanley.

Over 2,300 containers have been moved via BIL and over 8,000 head of cattle.
