## Updated vehicle rebate

The Federal Government’s Department of Infrastructure has recently reviewed the Bass Strait Passenger Vehicle Equalisation Scheme rebates. Rebates have been adjusted to reflect the annual Consumer Price Index.

The new rebates, which are to commence from 1 July 2018 are as follows:

Type of vehicle	One way trip	Round trip
Motor Car	Up to \$229	Up to \$458
Bus	Up to \$229	Up to \$458
Motorhome	Up to \$459	Up to \$918
Eligible passenger vehicle towing a caravan	Up to \$459	Up to \$918
Motorcycle	Up to \$117	Up to \$234
Bicycle	Up to \$34	Up to \$68
