Grassy automated weighbridge

Users of TasPorts' automated King Island weighbridge are now required to use the automated system only.

TasPorts account holders will need to have contacted the Tasmanian Scale Company in Burnie to complete the setup on 6431 3986 if they have not already done so.

All weighbridge use will be invoiced on a monthly basis. The system sends daily emails reporting on the previous day's usage.
